After a Ready, Set, Read! workshop:

- More than 90% of parents understood the connection between reading and their children's future success;
- Parents' confidence and mastery of techniques for reading to their children improved;
- Parents left workshops with at least one or more valuable strategies or beliefs about reading to their child;
- 97% of 221 survey respondents commented that they learned something new during the parent workshop.

Ready, Set, Read! provides classroom lending libraries and instructional bilingual workshops to help underserved parents read to their kids. Focusing on pre-kindergarten children, our programs stress the importance of a parent's role in a child's literacy development, ongoing academic success, and overall self-confidence.

Since 2000, through the donations and hard work of generous donors, volunteers, and motivated educators, we have taught over 14,000 parents to read with their children more often and effectively, given each of those parents a book to take home and read to their child, and distributed over 150 classroom lending libraries.



Techniques.

The Ready, Set, Read! workshop is the culmination of years of research and hands-on experience. Parents are taught the dialogic method for reading to their children. Dialogic reading is based upon three main techniques- asking "what" questions, asking openended questions, and expanding upon what the child says.

READY to become an active partner in their child's literacy development.

SE to implement the dialogic reading techniques they have learned.

Parents learn that the time they spend with their children looking at books and discussing them is invaluable, regardless of their reading skills.


